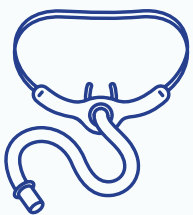

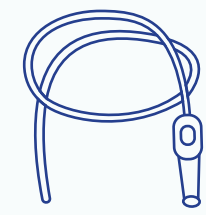
Management of

alarms

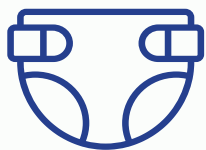


Nasal or
